Participants will take part in two major programs in the spring of 2027.

FIRST AMENDMENT INSTITUTE (FAI)

 Chicago, Illinois  January 29-31, 2027



An intensive 1.5-day leadership experience where students learn from a range of experts about current threats to their First Amendment freedom of association and freedom of speech rights on campus.

- Gain the personal skills needed to be prominent advocates for protecting the Greek experience
- Build bonds with top student leaders from campuses across the country
- Leave equipped to educate and empower fellow students

GREEK CONGRESSIONAL HILL DAY

 Washington, DC  Q1 or April 2027
(exact dates TBD)



1.5 days of training to be effective lobbyists and powerful advocates for the Greek experience, followed by a full day on Capitol Hill meeting with Members of Congress and staff.

- Teams of students and national alumni leaders meet with 8-10 Congressional offices
- Learn from professionals in public policy and program alumni
- Attend a reception/dinner with Greek Senators, Representatives, and Congressional staff
- NIC lobbying focuses on critical pro-Greek legislative priorities, such as freedom of association, Greek housing, and strong anti-hazing policies
